Biography



Originally from Northeastern Pennsylvania, Bill Rosser has been part of the East Coast music scene for over 30 years. As both guitar player and lead singer in numerous bands, Bill has played in all sorts of venues from small clubs to football stadiums to CBGB's to TV's "Live From The Bubba Mac Shack". Bill has opened shows for the likes of Molly Hatchet, .38 Special, Black Oak Arkansas, Van Zant, The Outlaws, and Pure Prairie League.

As part owner of CSS Recording, Bill has written and produced commercial music for The National Guard for use in both TV and Radio advertising. In 1999 Bill teamed up with Reading, Pennsylvania's Charlie Fick to assemble a first class group of players with roots in Blues and Southern Rock. The result was Shotgun Blue. Their first CD entitled "Chucky" received significant regional airplay and continues to be requested today.

In 2006, Bill and Charlie again collaborated in *Steelhorse, A Tribute To Southern Rock* where Bill is currently the lead singer.

Bill has been playing guitar since grade school and his collection includes a rare 1960 single pickup Teisco Del Rey, a 1969 (pre-production) Les Paul Recorder, a mid-seventies Fender Stratocaster, a Gibson SG, an Ovation acoustic, and a Samick D5 Acoustic.

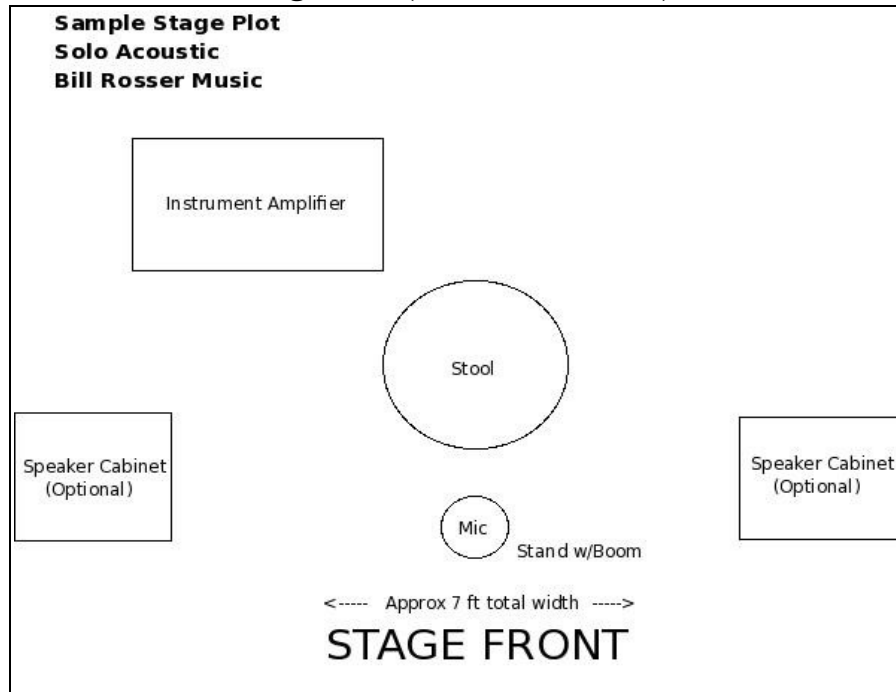

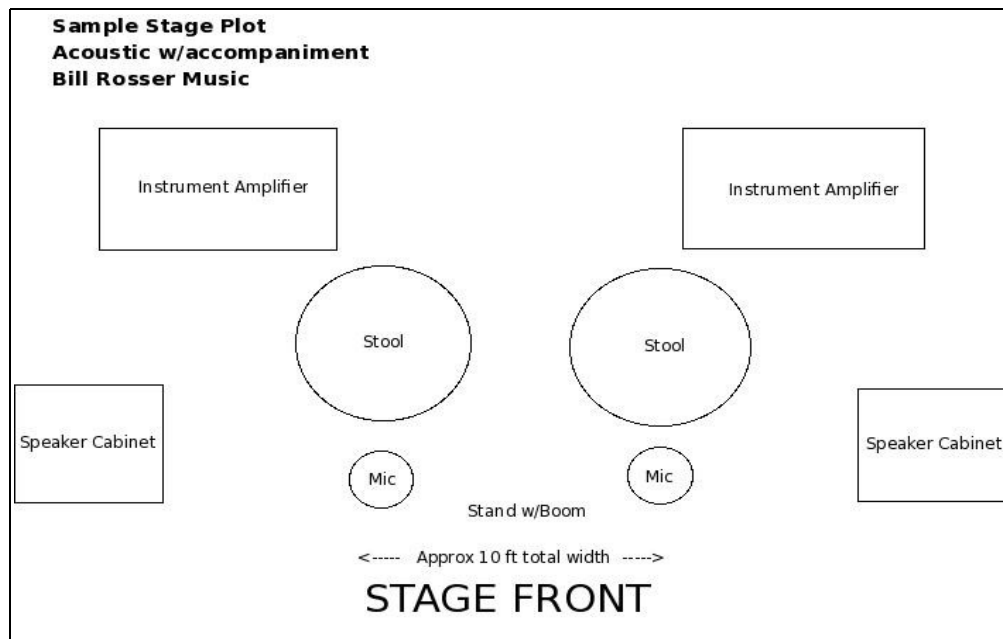
